Background summary: The Commission was petitioned in June 2019 to restore a year-round fishing season to the portion of the Colville River which extends from the mouth upstream to the bridge at the town of Valley. This portion of the Colville River was moved to a standard stream season (Sat. before Memorial Day-Oct. 31) during rule simplification in 2018. Prior to that, it had been regulated under a year-round open fishing season since 1950. Following the change enacted during rule simplification, staff received comments from the public and elected officials stating concern that the new season unnecessarily limits recreational opportunity, with much of the trout fishing opportunity occurring in late winter/early spring, prior to the current season opener. During that time, fishing conditions are more favorable than later in the spring and summer when water quality makes fishing difficult.
