WAC 220-416-010 Small game and other wildlife seasons and regulations.

Recommended Adjustment

Remove the proposed rimfire rifle fall turkey season under Section (8)(b).

(8) FALL TURKEY GENERAL SEASONS:

(b) HUNTING METHOD RESTRICTION: It is unlawful to hunt turkeys with rifles during the fall season EXCEPT rimfire rifles may be used from October 15 – November 15.

Comments received prior to briefing:

- Through online survey 1,553
 - Agree 976 (63%)
 - Disagree 161 (10%)
 - Neutral 416 (27%)
- Several respondents expressed mixed responses



Comments received: March 26 Commission meeting

- 4 of 10 individuals spoke specific to the proposed changes in this rule (220-416-010) during the session
 - 2 opposed the addition of a rimfire rifle turkey season; but would support the proposed limited time frame (October 15-November 15)
 - 1 supported rimfire rifle turkey season.
 - 1 requested a spring grouse season to offset the proposed two-week delay of fall season.



WAC 220-417-010 Trapping seasons and regulations

Recommended Adjustment

Remove the proposal to add season requirements, daily bag limits, and possession limits for:

- Eastern cottontail,
- Nuttall's cottontail, and
- Snowshoe hare.



These species will <u>not</u> be added to the trapping regulations



Comments received prior to briefing

- Through online survey 1,501
 - Agree 676 (45%)
 - Disagree 140 (9%)
 - Neutral 685 (46%)
- Letters/email correspondences
 - Requesting closure of beaver trapping on public land



Comments received: March 26 Commission meeting

Six Individuals provided verbal comments specific to this proposal

- No comments about the change in marten season or bag limit.
- Four individuals requested restricting beaver trapping to areas of reintroduction, wetland restorations, or eliminating trapping
- Two individuals spoke in favor of beaver trapping
