Wild Washington Crab Pumpkin Carving Template

Instructions:

1. Print a copy of the template and tape it on your pumpkin.
2. Transfer the design to the pumpkin by poking small holes along the black lines using a thumb tack or pumpkin carving tool.
3. Remove the template (but be sure to keep it as a reference) and begin cutting out the design left on your pumpkin. Add some detail if you like!
4. Add a light and watch your animal glow!

Crab

Did you know crabs are nocturnal? Most crabs spend their days hiding from predators, and emerge at night to hunt. Of the eight species commonly found in Washington waters, five are considered invasive species!
