Wild Washington Owl Pumpkin Carving Template

Instructions:

1. Print a copy of the template and tape it on your pumpkin.
2. Transfer the design to the pumpkin by poking small holes along the black lines using a thumb tack or pumpkin carving tool.
3. Remove the template (but be sure to keep it as a reference) and begin cutting out the design left on your pumpkin. Add some detail if you like!
4. Add a light and watch your animal glow!

Owl

Flying silently as the night, owls are adapted with specialized feathers that allow air to pass through them without making a sound. This helps these nocturnal hunters swoop down on their prey undetected!
