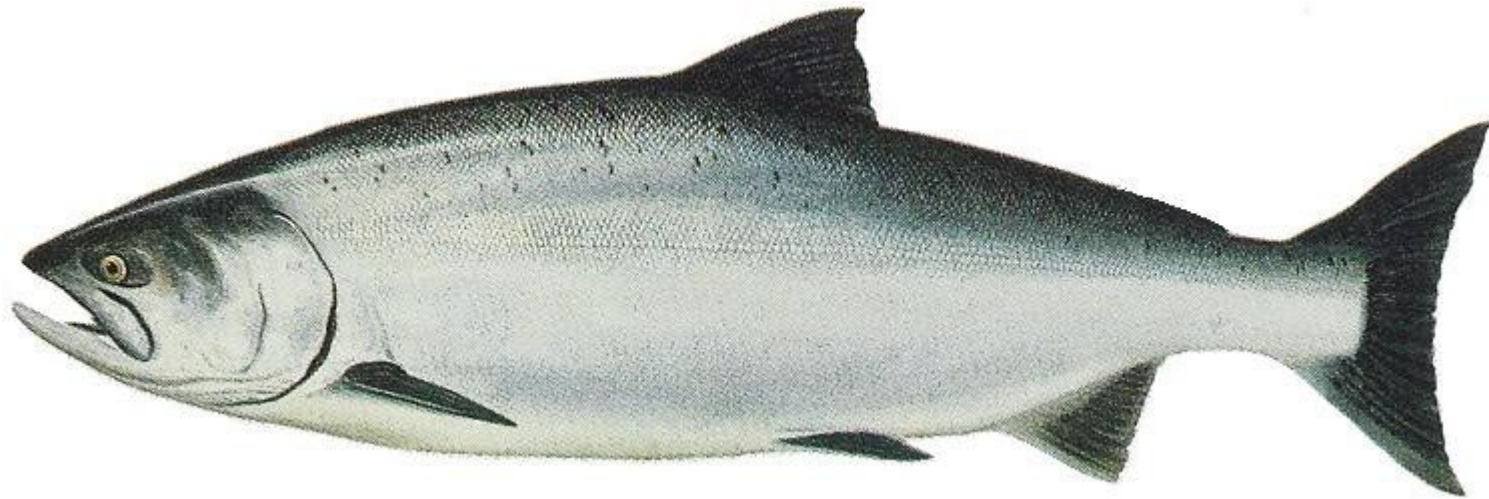

## Instructions for completing Logbook forms

**FORM RF-2.** This form is used to provide information on the general composition of Chinook and Coho being intercepted during the timeframe reef nets are allowed retention of marked Chinook and unmarked Coho. Fill in the blanks or circle the number(s) of the fields that are applicable. Fill out sheets **only for sets** where you encounter Chinook and Coho. Sign and date each sheet that is submitted.

### TOP OF THE PAGE

Enter Vessel License Holder Name, common name for Location, Fish Ticket series #'s the Chinook were recorded on, Directed species that the opening was for, and the Longitude / Latitude (to the nearest decimal minute) location of fishing vessel.

### DAILY FISHING SECTIONS

1. SET: Enter the set number performed.
2. DATE: Enter the month and date, both in numerical forms.
3. TIDE: Circle the appropriate code number identifying the tide during the time this set occurred.
4. CHINOOK ENCOUNTERS:
  - NO. MARKED: Enter the number of marked Chinook **encountered** in set.
  - NO. UNMARKED: Enter the number of unmarked Chinook **encountered** in set.
5. COHO ENCOUNTERS:
  - NO. MARKED: Enter the number of marked Coho **encountered** in set. NO.
  - UNMARKED: Enter the number of unmarked Coho **encountered** in set.
6. OTHER BYCATCH: Enter other species (using codes listed above) and number encountered in set.
7. COMMENTS: Record any observations related to fishing activities such as bird signs, vessels seen during the day, percentage or numbers of catch that had gill net scars, movement of fish, or other anecdotal information that you feel is useful.
8. TOTAL # OF SETS: Enter the **total** number of sets performed for the day (regardless if you retained Chinook in them or not).
9. TOTAL: Sum the above columns (this column does not have to be filled out by the fisher, if they wish to leave blank that is OK).

## Submitting Logbooks

Completion of this logbook is mandatory for all Puget Sound reef net gear operators that participate in retaining marked Chinook and unmarked Coho during the upcoming Puget Sound commercial season, as an all gear cap of 300 marked Chinook and 1000 unmarked Coho will be closely monitored.
