Hello Everyone,

It's that time of year again when WDFW south coast marine fisheries staff for Willapa Bay will be providing in-season weekly updates regarding recreational and commercial fisheries, hatchery broodstock, and spawning ground surveys as we move through the fall season. Recreational Marine Area Fishery

The Willapa Bay recreational marine fishery opened on June 30, 2024, under Ocean Area 2 rules. Our recreational creel monitoring began on opening day and included the Tokeland boat launch and marina and the South Bend boat launch. We have had a better start to the 2024 salmon fishing season compared to last year during the same timeframe in July, but we did see effort pick up the week of July 22 then drop back down the last week of July. This may be due to several factors including a push of salmon into Willapa Bay that week or better fishable tides (high tide in the early morning hours). There were only a few days in July when high water occurred first thing in the morning (the most favored tide for Willapa Bay marine recreational). A midday high tide may have contributed to less fish biting given the warmer weather conditions, which may have also discouraged some anglers, but there were many anglers we interviewed who were crabbing inside Willapa bay in the early weeks of the fishery. Staff reported 47 Chinook salmon (15 unmarked, 32 AD-clipped) and 52 Ad-clipped coho landed in June and July.

August 1st signified a change in regulations from Ocean Area 2 rules to Willapa Bay specific rules. The regulations for 2024 starting August 1 are the same as the 2023 salmon season including the Willapa Bay Control Zone that is once again open for the August – September timeframe. During August and September, staff will monitor dockside locations that include both the Tokeland boat launch and marina, and the South Bend boat launch two days per strata (strata 1: Monday – Thursday; strata 2: Friday – Sunday). Staff saw an increase in effort the first full week of August with the highest effort for the week on Sunday, August 11. From August 1 – 11, there were several days (August 9-13) with an early morning high tide, the most favorable tide for Willapa Bay, however, it was a big tidal exchange with a minus tide at low water. The overall weather conditions were warmer throughout the day as well. There were 29

hatchery Chinook salmon estimated to have been caught in the first weeks from August 1 – 11. (See attachment: 2024 WB Marine Area Recreational Catch Estimate Summary Draft 08.16.2024.pdf)

For this week, August 12 - 18, there will be early morning and early evening high tides with smaller tidal exchanges, but it includes a few minus tides at low water later in the week starting Friday, August 16. This tide series will continue until well into the following week. Spawning Ground Surveys

Staff started weekly stream surveys on August 1 below the weir in Nemah and Naselle rivers. We have observed roughly 101 live Chinook salmon staging in the Naselle River and only 3 live Chinook staging in the Nemah River. At this point, we have not observed any spawning or redds in either of these river sections. Historically, Chinook salmon begin spawning in Willapa Bay rivers the middle of September.

Hatchery Chinook Rack Returns

Naselle River Hatchery

To-date, 35 adult and 0 jack hatchery Chinook salmon have volunteered into the attraction channel and recruited into the hatchery. This is significantly lower than last year at this time. There have also been five unmarked, Chinook salmon that have volunteered into the hatchery at this point. Three were male Chinook and two was a female Chinook. All five fish have been planted upstream above the hatchery. There has been one female Chinook salmon mortality reported in the Naselle Hatchery last week from August 1 – 13, 2024. Nemah and Forks Creek hatcheries

To-date, there have been two hatchery, male Chinook volunteer into the pond at the Nemah Hatchery.

No Chinook salmon have recruited into the Forks Creek Hatchery at this point.

Commercial Fishery

The commercial fishery in Willapa Bay is scheduled to open tomorrow, August 17, at the south end of the bay using tangle net gear in Areas 2N, 2M, and 2R. An update from this opener will be provided in next week's weekly update email.

As always, in-season data is preliminary and subject to change.
