


Parcel Map Black River County:Thurston Proposed T16R02W T16R03W Wildlife Area Units 36 WA Department of Natural Resources

- 2,382 acres
- **Scatter Creek Vicinity**
- Pass Thru to partner
- Possible area for future wildlife crossing over I-5





Black River, Thurston County

- Creates the largest wildlife corridor region between Black River riparian, Scatter Creek Wildlife Area, Capital Forest, and the Glacial Heritage Preserve
- Habitat: conifer forest
- Species: elk, Columbian black-tailed deer, coho, Townsend big eared bat, coastal cutthroat
- Recreation: this conservation easement will not include recreation
