- Habitat: critical biodiversity corridor comprised of mixed habitats such as shrubsteppe, mixed conifer, and riparian.
- Species: elk and deer, including mule deer winter range, Columbian sharp-tailed grouse, golden eagle
- Recreation: Ample wildlife-related recreation in the forms of hiking, biking, horseback riding, and nature viewing and high-quality hunting opportunities, particularly big game.
