Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the determination of non-significance for the Sol Duc Hatchery Weir Permanent Replacement Project (24-030) located at 1432 Pavel Road as proposed by WA Department of Fish and Wildlife, Doug Wiedemeier. The Department of Ecology (Ecology) reviewed the environmental checklist and has the following comment(s):

Thank you for providing the Department of Ecology the opportunity to review this proposal. The project appears to propose reconfiguring and expanding an in-stream structure, which requires a shoreline Conditional Use Permit in the Residential Conservancy and Resource Conservancy environments. The project will need to be consistent with the Shoreline Management Act, Conditional Use Permit criteria in WAC 173-27-160, and applicable portions of the Clallam County Shoreline Master Program, including Section 4.5, Instream Structures and Chapter 6, Shoreline Buffers and Vegetation Conservation.
