DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: DNS 25-002: RULE MAKING FOR PROHIBITION OF FEEDING

WILDLIFE

Description of Proposal: The Department of Fish and Wildlife is proposing a permanent rule that prohibits individuals "to place, deposit, distribute, or scatter feed including, but not limited to, grain, hay, minerals, salt, fruit, or other such substances or food types to feed, lure or attract deer, elk, or moose not lawfully held in captivity." This rule is being proposed in association with several other rule adjustments intended to minimize the spread of chronic wasting disease, a disease that affects deer, elk, and moose and was detected in eastern Washington in August of 2024. The rule, if adopted, would prohibit feeding deer, elk, and moose by any individual on public and private land including residences (e.g., backyards). This rule is separate but similar to other proposed rules that prohibit feeding deer, elk, or moose for the purpose of hunting.
