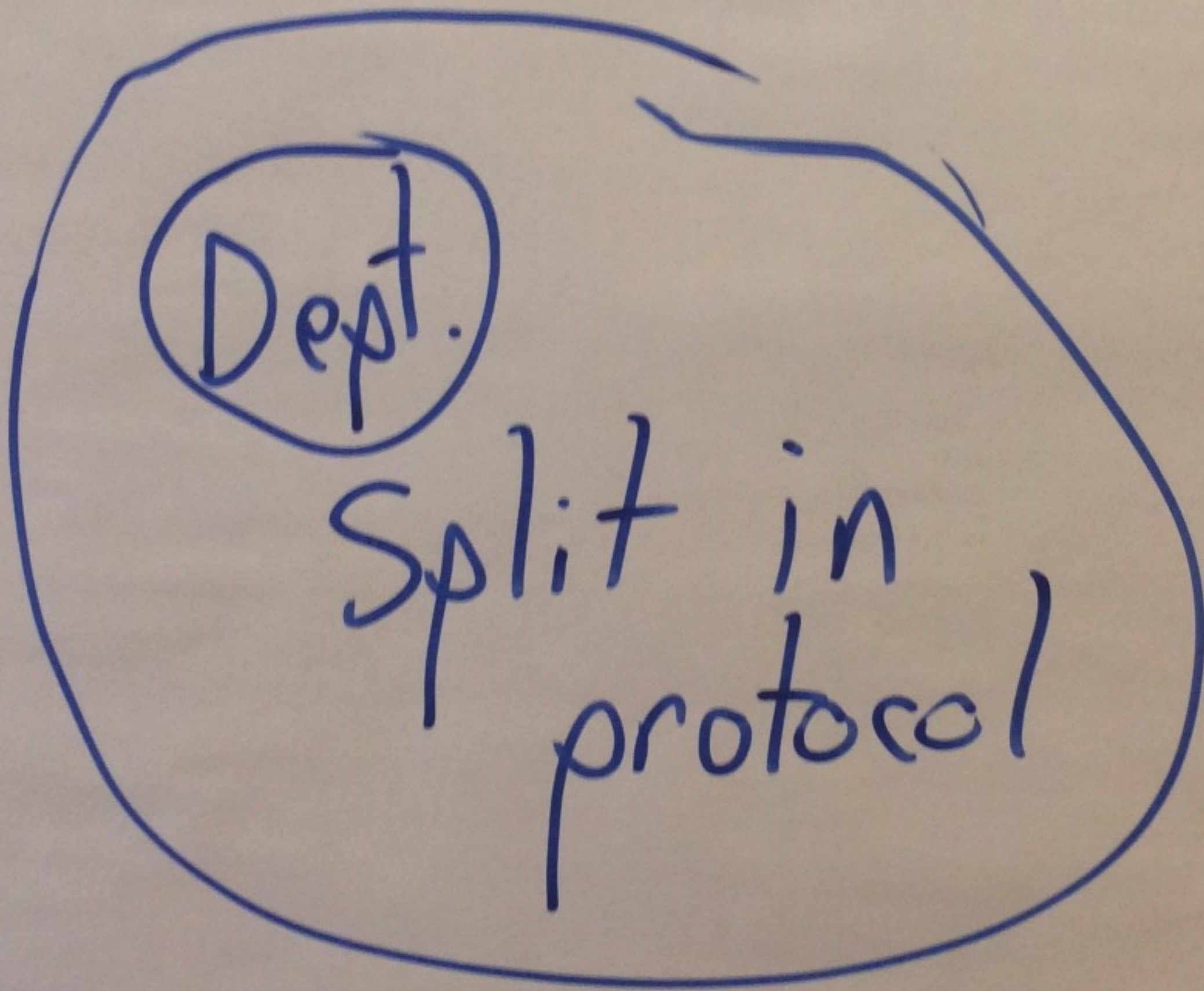

RANGE RIDER

MINIMUM-

- RR REQUIRED COMMUNICATION W/ PRODUCER / WDFW ON LIVESTOCK INJURY, MORTALITY, MOVEMENTS

RANGE RIDER

MIN. CONT. -

- KNOWLEDGE OF GRAZING LOCATION, LIVESTOCK, AND WILDLIFE
- KNOWLEDGE OF DETERRENTS / EFFECTIVENESS

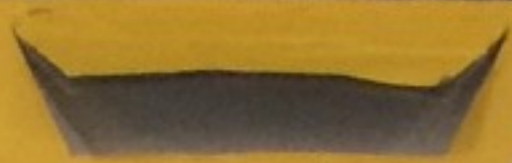
