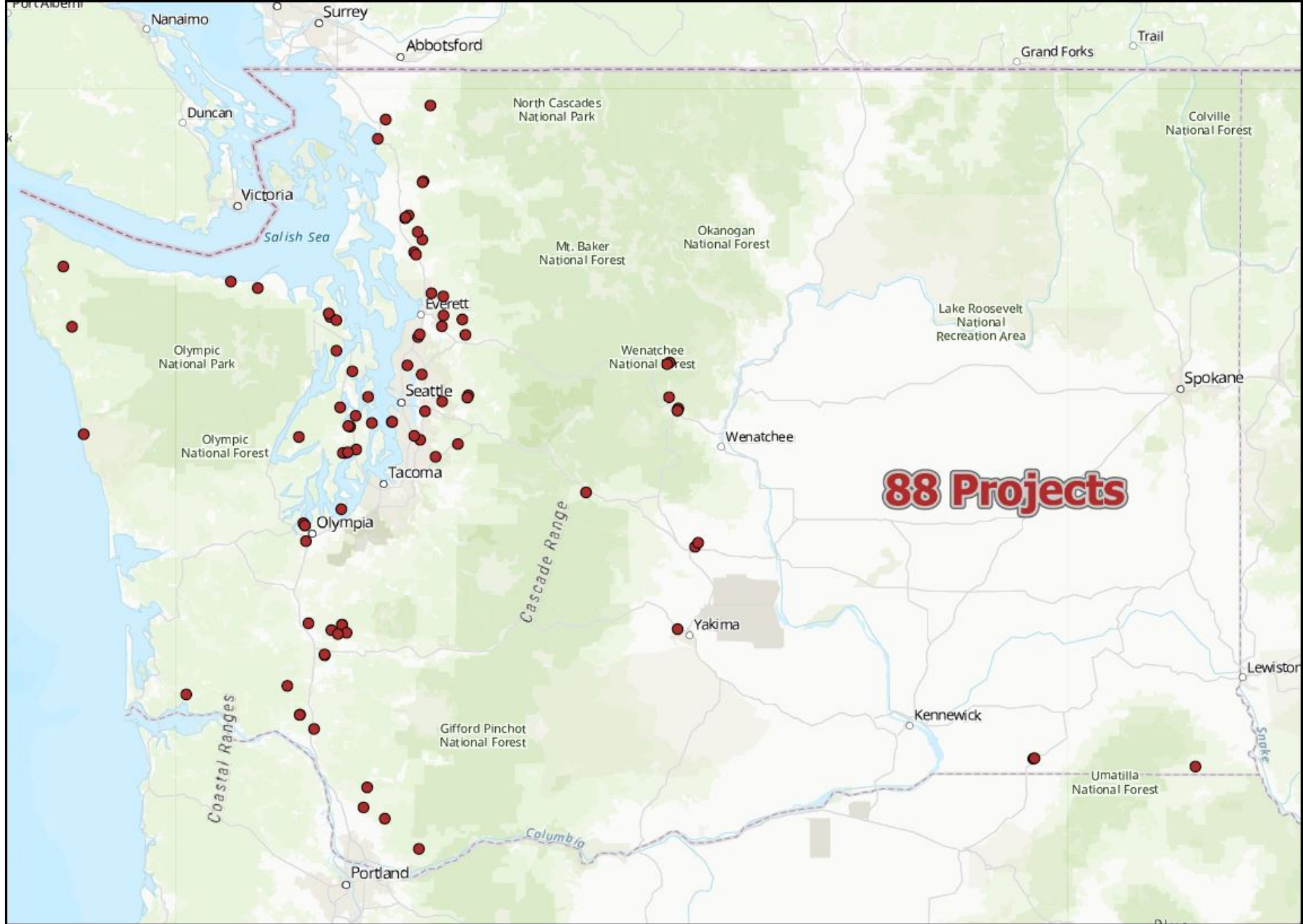

  - 1 State Parks Owned



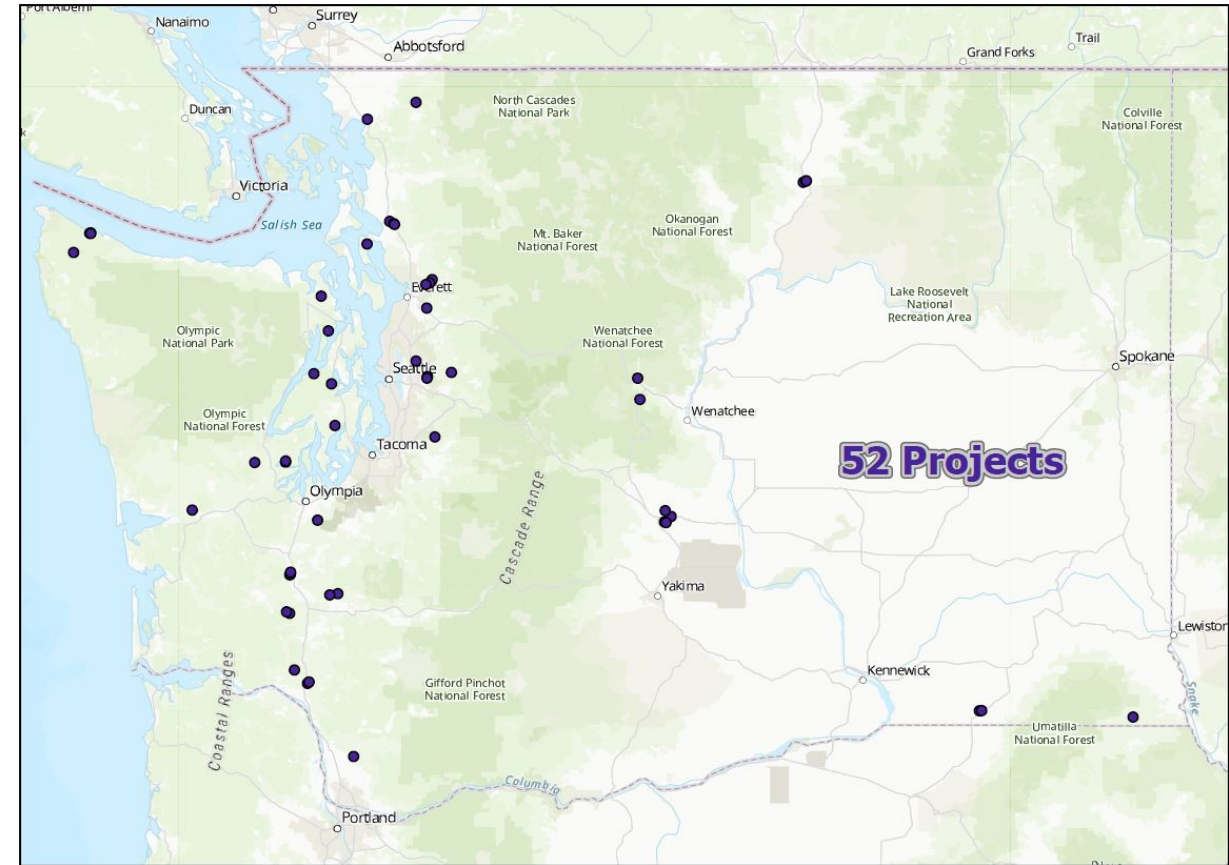
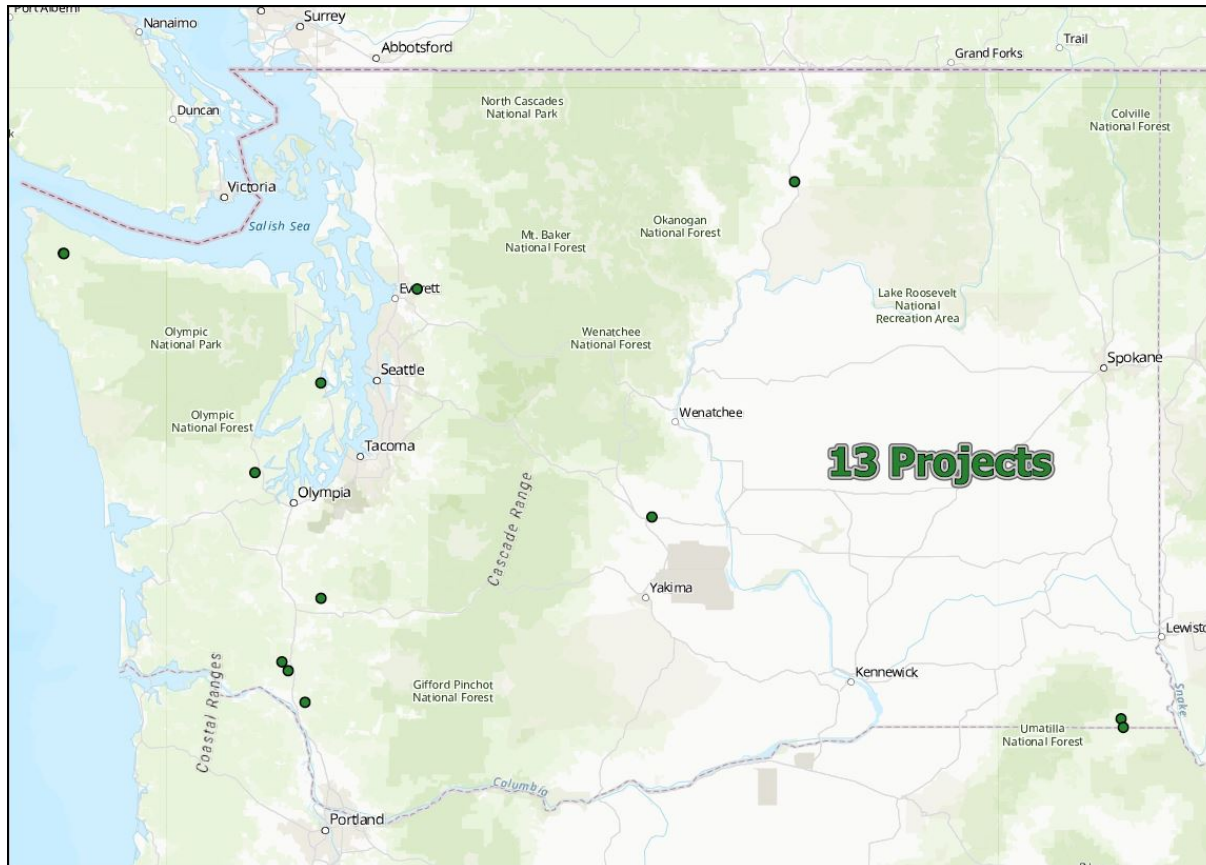

2017-2019 and 2019-2021





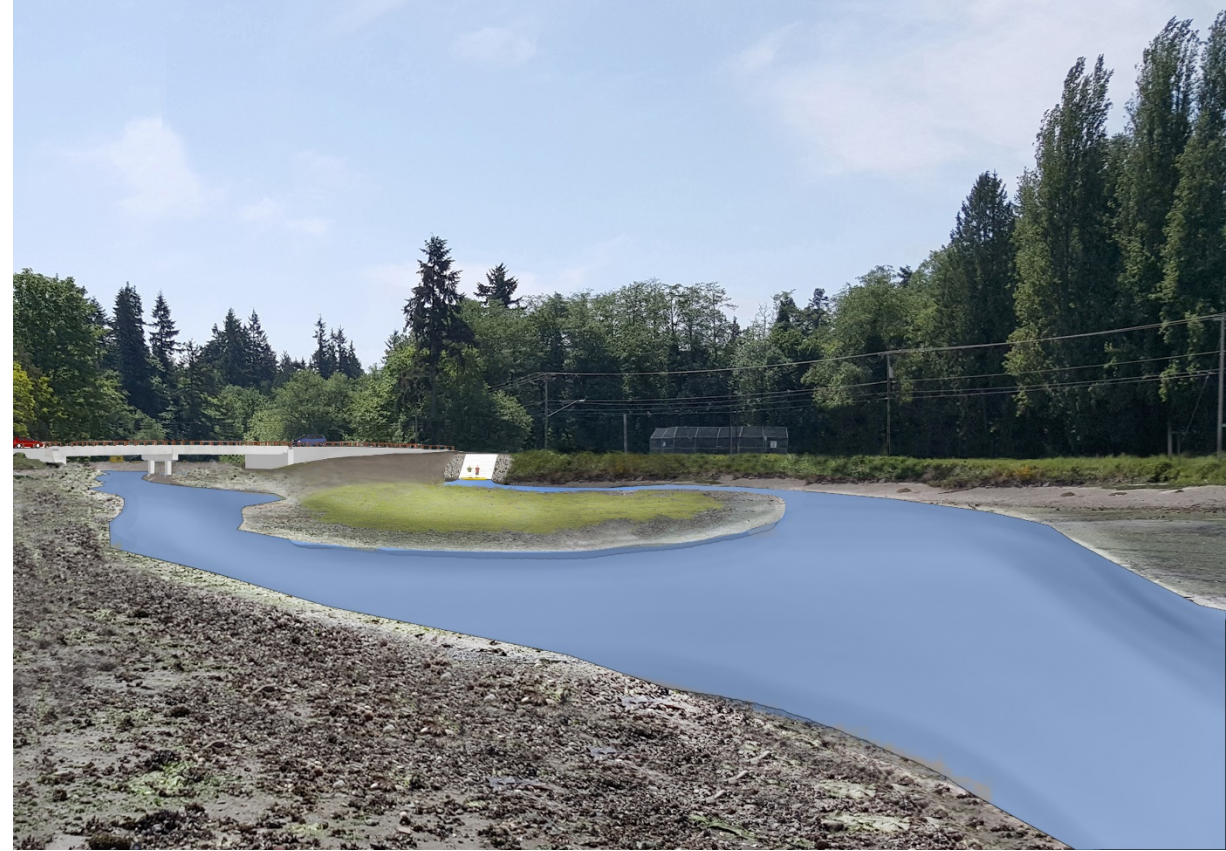
# A Closer Look at Projects

## Harper Estuary Culvert Removal and Bridge

- PRISM ID: 20-1608
- FPDSI Site ID: 932931
- Scope: Restoration
- Funding Request: \$4.1M
- Location: Kitsap County
- Ownership: County

## Issue(s):

- Small gain to small systems
- High price tag
- Some project elements may not be fundable
  - Building a pedestrian pathway
- One of the few estuary projects

## McDonald Creek Fish Passage

- PRISM ID: 20-1730
- FPDSI Site ID: 18.0160 3.30
- Scope: Restoration
- Funding Request: \$406,415K
- Location: Clallam County
- Ownership: Irrigation District

## Issue(s):

- Altering dam and improving fishway
- Multiple biologists have weighed in on project
- Committed recent hydraulic violation

## Coal Creek Fish Passage Improvement Project: I-405

- PRISM ID: 20-1733
- FPDSI Site ID: 08.0268 0.82
- Scope: Planning
- Funding Request: \$600,00K
- Location: King County
- Ownership: City

## Issue(s):

- Small linear gain due to similar structure immediately upstream
- Would really be better to include a partnership with the upstream King County project (started talks in Jan 2020)

- Scope: Restoration
- Funding Request: \$625,943K

- Funding used beyond water crossing?
  - Reed canary grass
  - Channel improvements

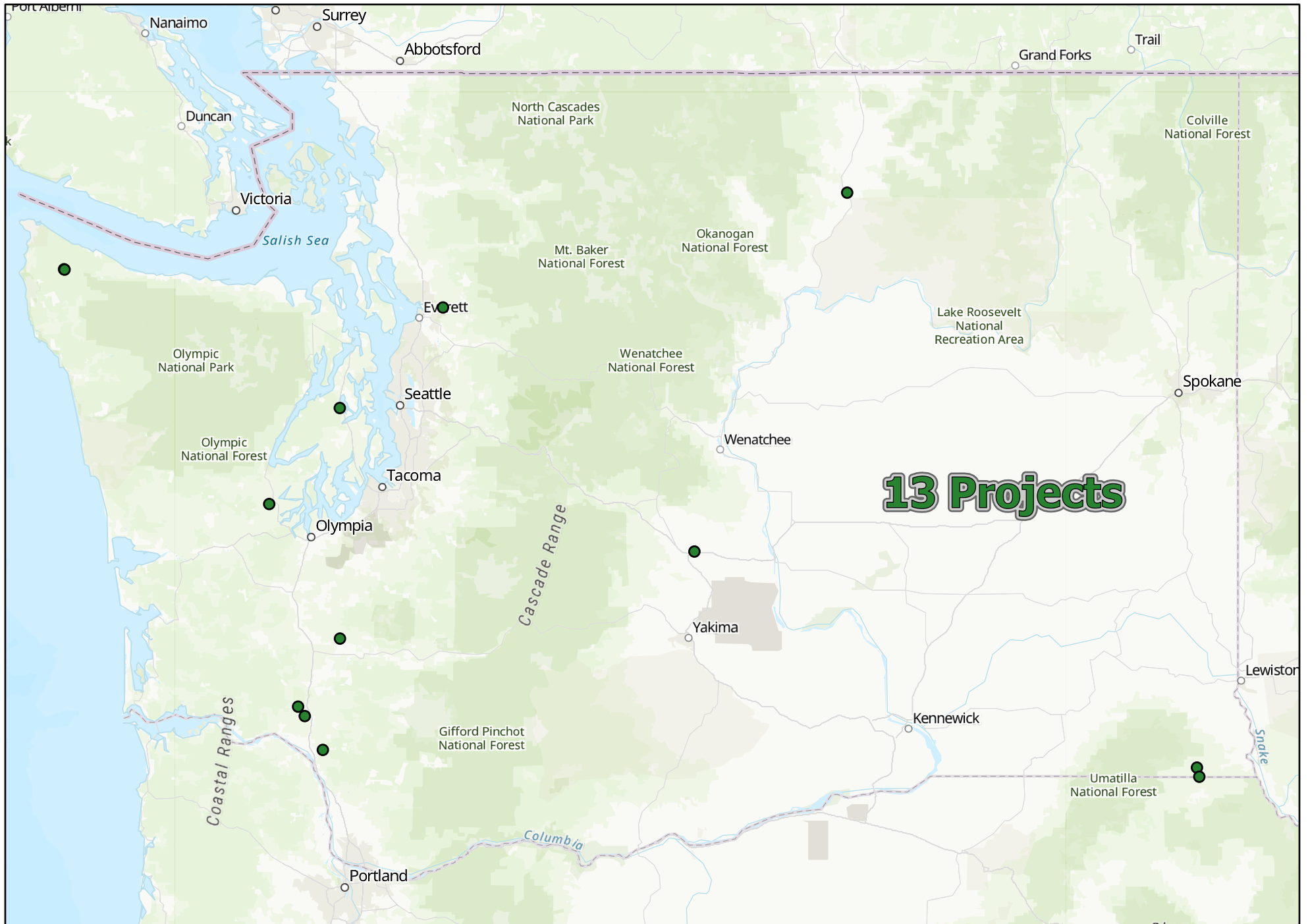

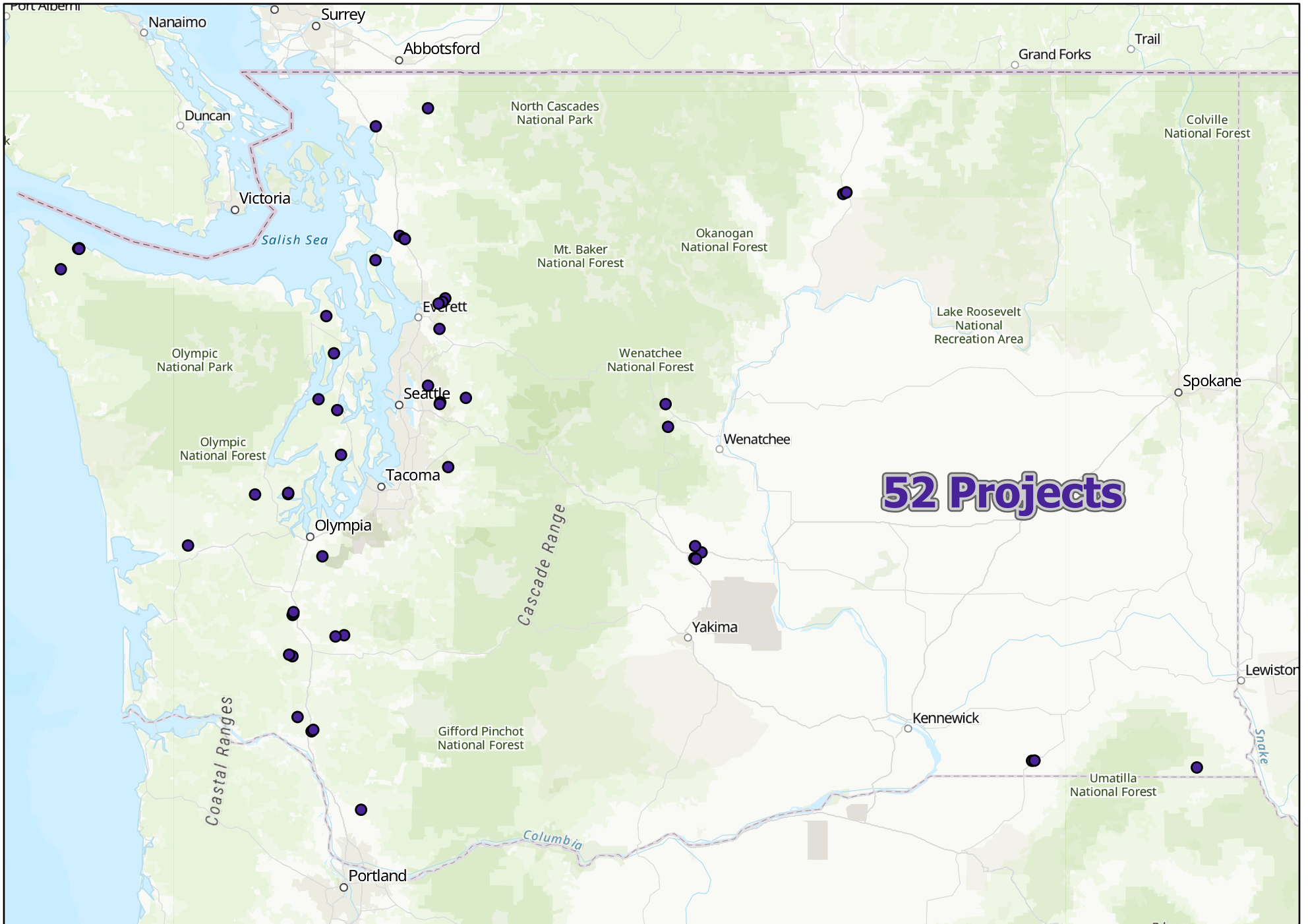




# Fish Barrier Removal Board: 2017 to 2019 Funded Projects

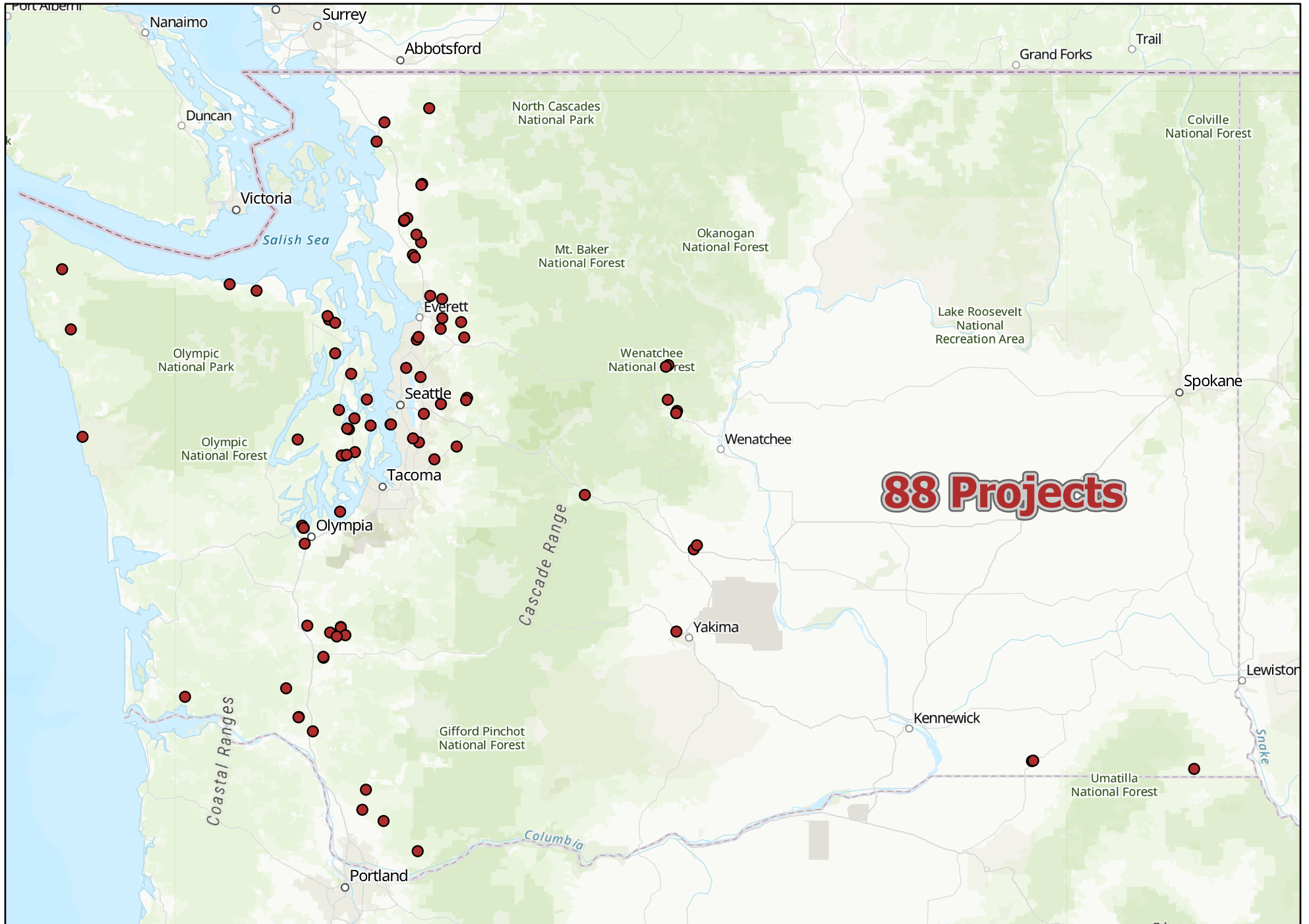


# Fish Barrier Removal Board: 2019 to 2021 Funded Projects
