General Season Deer

- Status quo for hunters with disabilities, youth, and seniors for NE white-tailed deer.
- Status quo for late archery in 105 and 108 which includes antlerless opportunity.
- Propose eliminating the Master Hunter whitetailed antierless hunts in GMUs 130-142.
 - Not consistent with the Master Hunter objective.
 - Late archery, late muzzleloader and special permits will meet the antierless removal needs.

General Season Deer

- Propose additional antlerless white-tailed deer opportunity for hunters with disabilities, youth, and seniors in Deer Areas 1050 (Spokane North), 1060 (Spokane South), 1070 (Spokane West), and 1080 (Colfax).
 - this was always intended to be a hwd/y/s opportunity, the original WAC was a typo.
- Propose shifting some Region 1, late archery dates to remove an overlap with modern firearm.
 - Recommended change would provide consistent, predictable start and stop dates.
 - In 2013 and 2014 also provides more hunting days than the old system that shifted with the calendar.

Special Permits Deer

- Propose increasing the Quality white-tailed deer opportunity in Spokane, Lincoln, and Whitman counties.
- Recommend shifting some of the 2nd deer antlerless opportunity to the antlerless category.
 - Hunters have expressed concerns about the cost of 2nd deer tag but still want the opportunity to harvest antierless deer.

Floor Amendments, Region 2

- Special Permits, Page 18, "Quality" category,
 - Sinlahekin, Modern, Nov. 1-20, change the permits from 5 permits to 10 permits.
 - Pogue, Modern Nov. 1-20, change the permits from 15 permits to 20 permits.
- Special Permits, Page 20, "Bucks" category,
 - Sinlahekin, Modern, Nov. 1-20, Any wtd buck, change the number of permits from 15 permits to 20 permits.
- Post-hunt surveys indicate that opportunity can be restored to 2011 levels.
