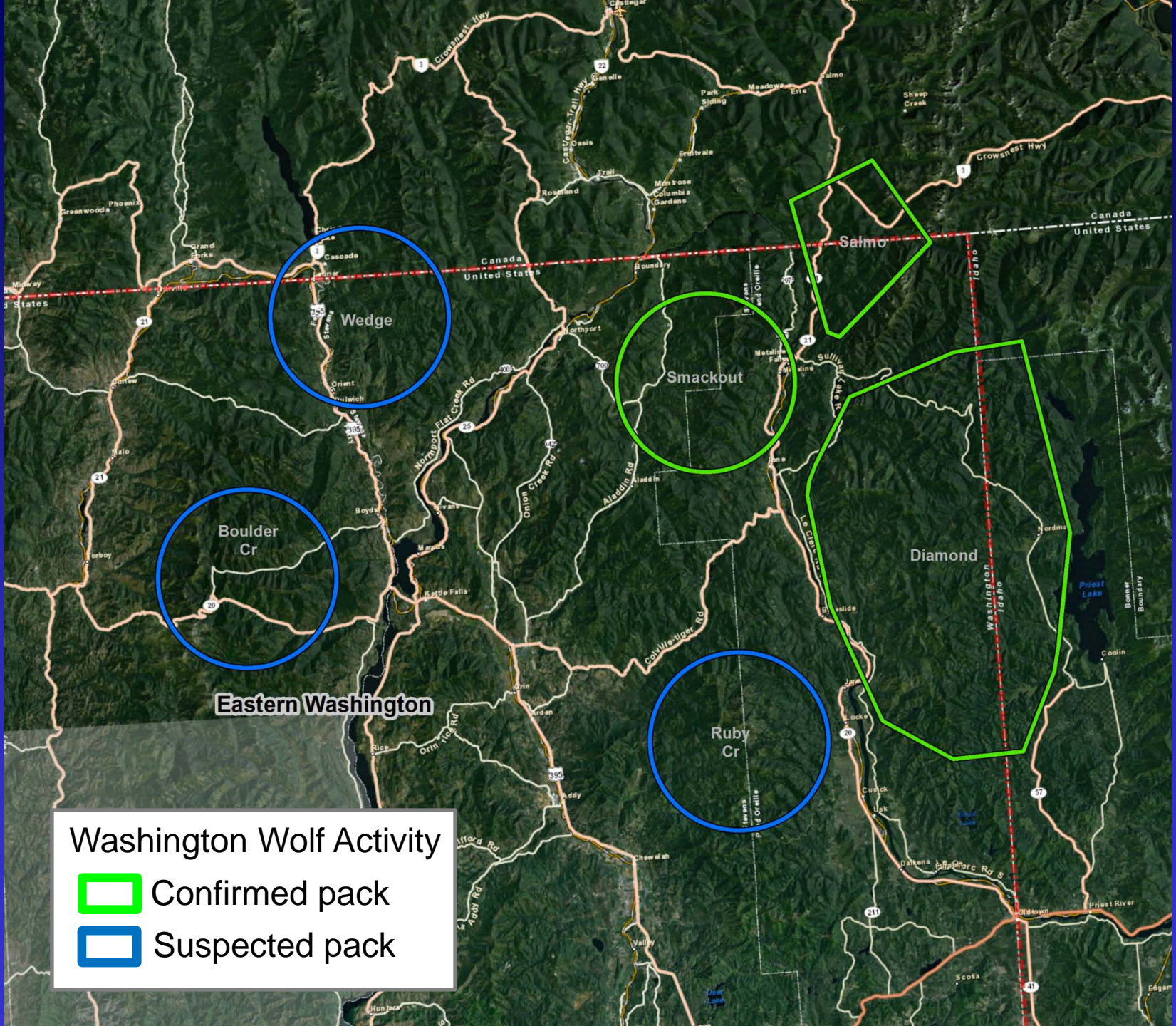

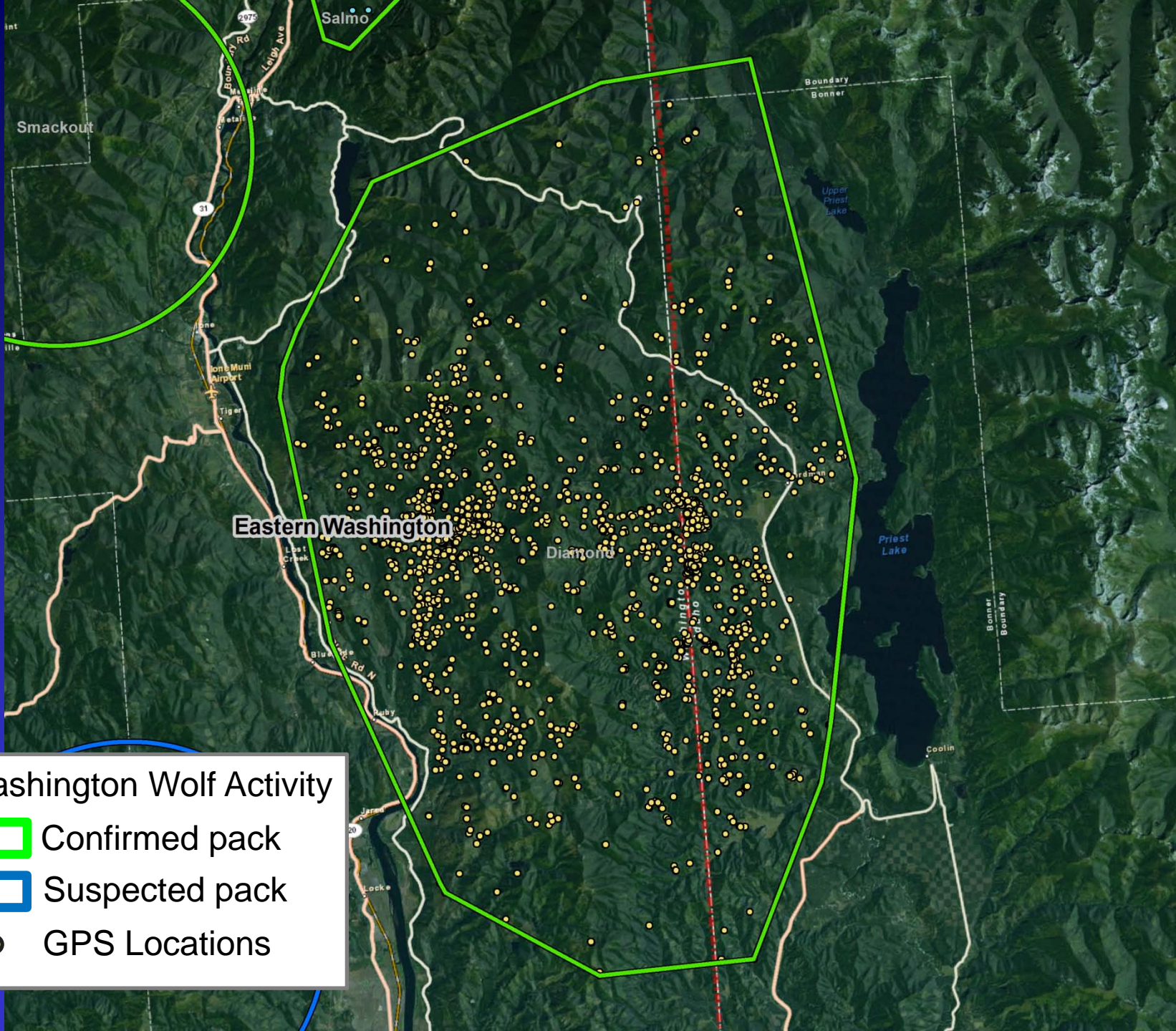

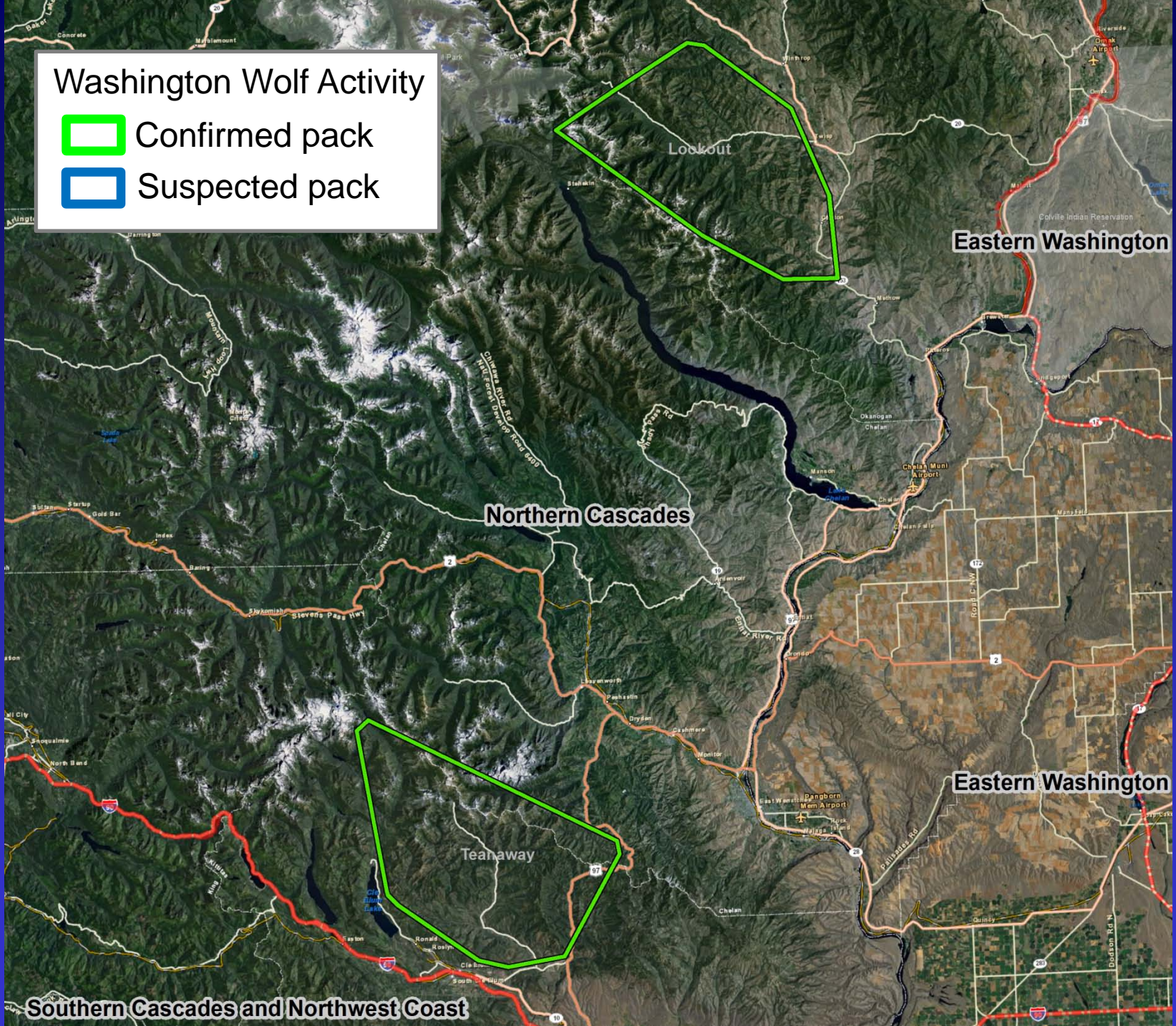

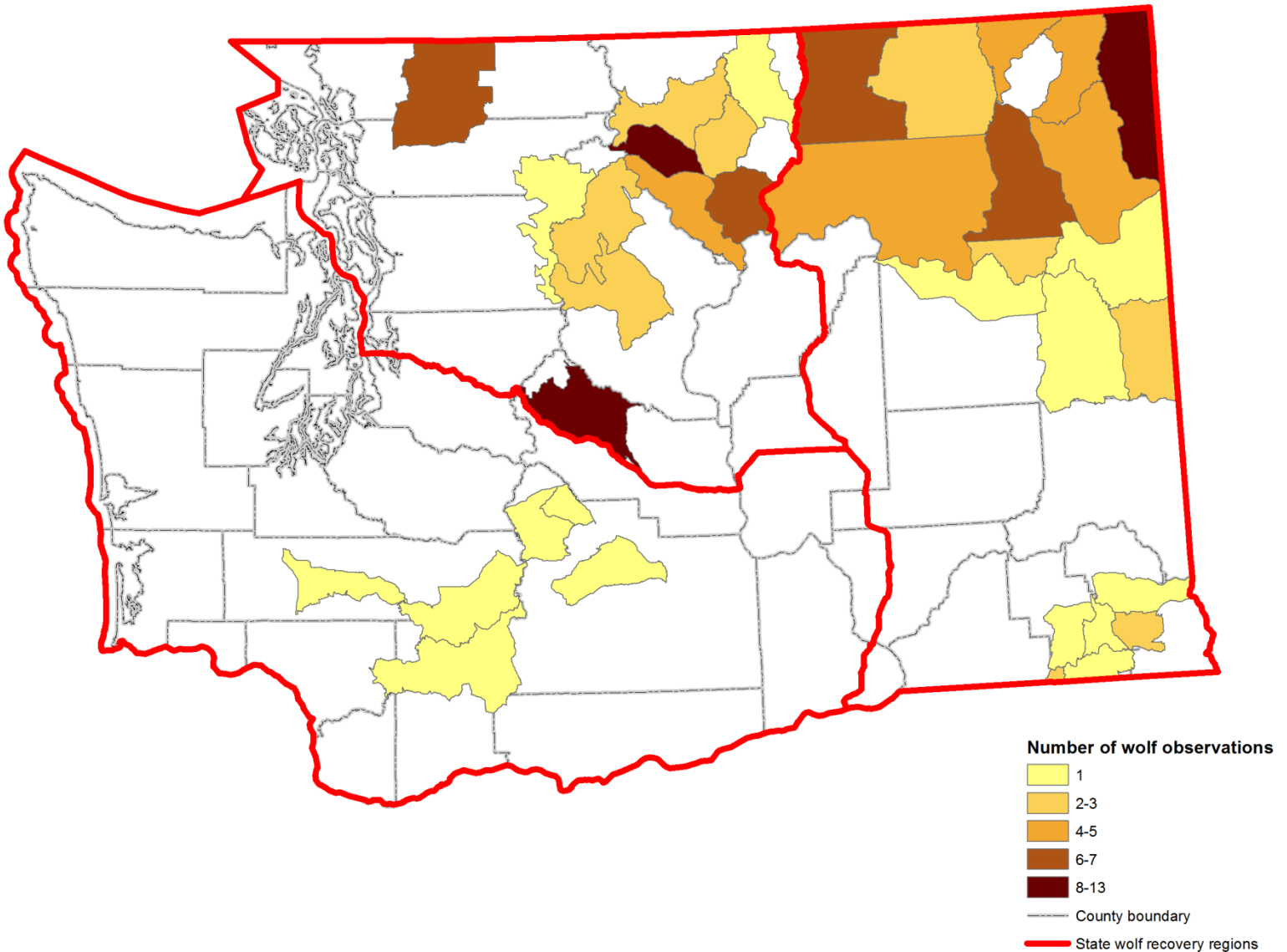

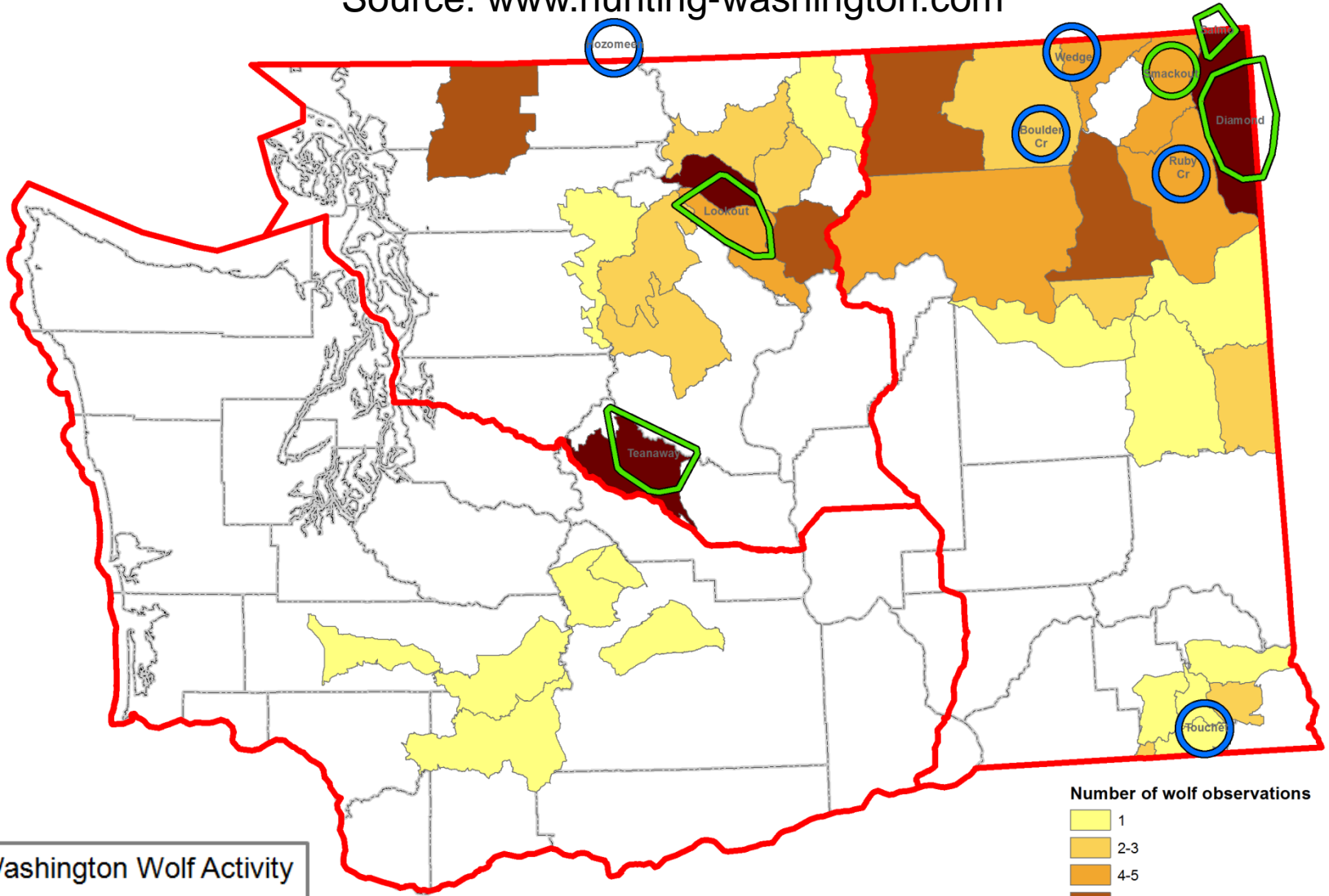

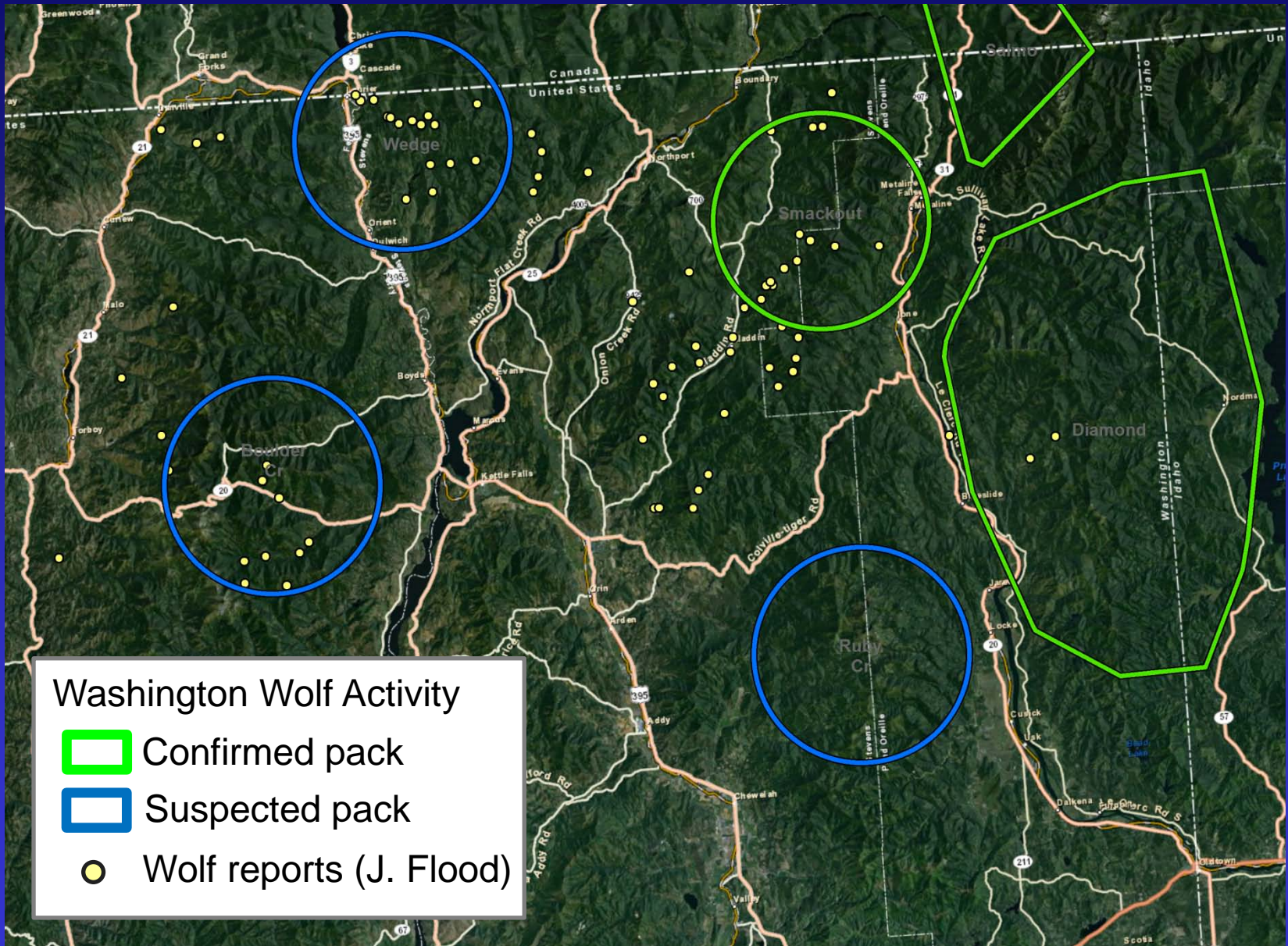

How to recognize a gray wolf

GRAY WOLF

Color: light gray to black
Dimensions: 2.5 feet tall, 5-6 feet long
Broad snout
Round ears



80-120 pounds
Paw size: 4" x 5"



COYOTE

Color: light gray/brown
Dimensions: 1.5 feet tall, 4 feet long
Tall pointed ears



Narrow snout
20-50 pounds
Paw size: 2" x 2.5"
