Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP) -

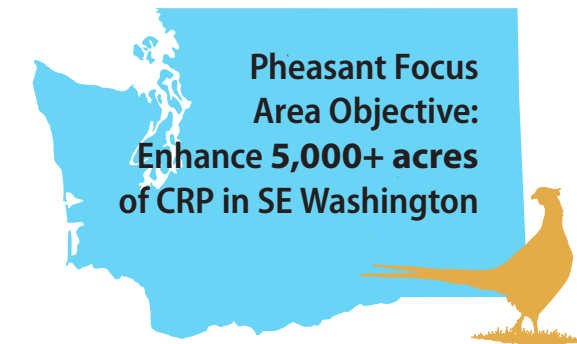
14,000 acres dedicated to restoring and protecting riparian habitat for salmon recovery.
