Background summary:

Staff will brief the Commission on proposed amendments to WAC 220-413-200 Reducing the spread of hoof disease – Unlawful transport of elk hooves, and request adoption of those amendments.

WAC 220-413-200 is intended to reduce the potential of spreading the causative bacterial agent(s) of treponeme associated hoof disease (TAHD). The rule restricts the transport of elk hooves from harvested animals that were killed in GMUs where TAHD has been confirmed. The rule provides an exception for those cooperating with Department directed management or research.

The proposed amendment adds four GMUs to the restriction. TAHD has been confirmed in GMU 568 and in the northwest corner of GMU 578 near the border of GMUs 574 and 572.

Policy issue(s) and expected outcome:

Restricting the movement of elk hooves from elk harvested in GMUs where TAHD has been confirmed or in GMUs with borders near where TAHD has been confirmed.

Fiscal impacts of agency implementation:

No fiscal impacts beyond the status quo.

Public involvement process used and what you learned:

The Department notified approximately 2,100 individuals informing them of the opportunity to provide comment on the proposed regulations. Additionally, these individuals and organizations were informed of the opportunity to provide verbal testimony at the September 14-15, 2018 Commission Meeting in Olympia.

Action requested and/or proposed next steps:

Amend WAC 200-413-413 as presented.

AMENDATORY SECTION (Amending WSR 17-17-088, filed 8/17/17, effective 9/17/17)

WAC 220-413-200 Reducing the spread of hoof disease—Unlawful transport of elk hooves. (1) It is unlawful to transport the hooves of harvested elk beyond the site where the animal was killed in Game Management Units 407, 418, 437, 454, 501 through 564, 568, 572, 574, 578, 633, 636 and 642 through 699, except when specifically authorized by the department or when acting as an agent of the department in the limited capacity of cooperating with research or management actions regarding hoof disease as directed by the department.

(2) Violation of this section is an infraction under RCW 77.15.160 Infractions.
