NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-04000R Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.

Effective July 25 through July 31, 2024, the following provisions of WAC 220-312-040 regarding Skagit River salmon seasons, shall be modified described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-040 not addressed herein, or unless otherwise amended, remain in effect:

Skagit River (Skagit Co.): From the Hwy. 536 (Memorial Hwy. Bridge) in Mt. Vernon to the Dalles Bridge at Concrete:

Salmon:

- (a) Daily limit 4. Release all salmon other than sockeye.
- (b) Night Closure in effect.
- (c) Selective gear rules are not in effect for salmon.
