WAC 220-312-05000V Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Eastside.

Effective August 15 through December 1, 2024, the following provisions of WAC 220-312-050, regarding fishing seasons in Rimrock Reservoir and Tieton River, South Fork shall be modified as follows. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-050 remain in effect unless modified by emergency rule:

(1) Rimrock Reservoir (Lake): From the intersection of USFS Rd 1200 (Tieton Reservoir Rd) and USFS Rd 1203 to the intersection of USFS Rd 1200 (Tieton Reservoir Rd) and USFS Rd 1000:

Game fish: Closed to shoreline (bank) fishing.

(2) **South Fork Tieton River:** From the mouth to USFS Rd 1070 bridge, including that portion that flows through the lakebed of Rimrock Reservoir lying north of the bridge on USFS Rd 1200 (Tieton Reservoir Rd):

Game fish: Closed to fishing.
