NEW SECTION

WAC 220-313-06000F Puget Sound salmon—saltwater seasons and daily limits.

Effective September 6 through September 30, 2024, the following provisions of WAC 220-313-060 regarding salmon seasons for Catch Record Card Area 11, shall be modified as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-313-060 not addressed herein, or unless otherwise amended by emergency rule, remain in effect:

Catch Record Card Area 11, except Des Moines Pier, Les Davis Pier, Point Defiance Boathouse Dock:

Salmon daily limit is 2. Release chum and wild Chinook.
