NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-04000S Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.

Effective immediately, through October 31, 2024, the following provisions of WAC 220-312-040 regarding recreational gamefish seasons for Deschutes River, shall be modified as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-040 not addressed herein, or unless otherwise amended by emergency rule, remain in effect:

Deschutes River (Thurston Co.), from the mouth (a line projected across the river 400 feet below the lower Tumwater Falls fish ladder) to the Old Highway 99 Bridge:

Gamefish: Closed.
