## WAC 220-312-03000F Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Southwest.

Effective September 16 through December 31, 2023, the provisions of WAC 220-312-030 regarding salmon in Yale Reservoir shall be modified as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-030 not addressed herein remain in effect unless otherwise amended by emergency rule:

**Yale Reservoir (Cowlitz Co.):** Landlocked salmon rules apply, except salmon maximum length is 15 inches.
