NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-04000W Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.

Effective September 26, 2024, until further notice, provisions of WAC 220-312-040 regarding salmon fishing seasons for the Stillaguamish River shall be modified as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-312- 040 not addressed herein, or unless otherwise amended by emergency rule remain in effect:

Stillaguamish River (Snohomish Co.) From Marine Drive (south of Stanwood) upstream to forks.

Daily limit: One salmon, release Chinook and chum.
