A petition to amend WAC 220-416-120 to allow blowguns as a method of taking bullfrog.
Presenter(s):

Background summary:
This petition asks the department to change WAC 220-416-120 to allow blowguns that use a tethered barbed dart for taking bullfrog. The current rule allows angling, hand dip netting, spearing (gigging), or bow and arrow as taking methods. Use of a blowgun would not be a great departure from the methods already allowed. Department staff recommend proposing this idea during the annual season setting rulemaking process that commences with CR-101 filing in December 2024 and ends with a decision by the Commission (or Director if delegated) in April 2025. Department staff are already considering additional methods of taking bullfrog that could also be brought forward during this rulemaking.
