NEW SUB-AREAS FOR DUNGENESS CRAB CAUGHT OFF OREGON

As of May 29, 2018, the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife is requiring dealers to note the specific harvest area(s) for Dungeness crab caught off of Oregon to assist in product traceability (OAR 635-006-0201). If crab is caught off of Oregon and landed into Washington (i.e., catch area 61), the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife is asking dealers to note the appropriate sub-area (shown in the attached) on the paper fish ticket or the electronic fish ticket. The catch area code will still be 61.
