Catchables: Trout that have been reared at WDFW facilities and are 2.0 to 2.5 fish per pound in size.

Put, Grow &Take: Trout that have been reared at WDFW facilities and are 2.6 to 10 fish per pound in size.

Jumbos: Trout that have been reared at WDFW facilities that weigh 1 pound or more each. Note: includes brood fish.

Triploids: Triploid trout that have been purchased by the WDFW. Each fish weighs about 1.5 pounds.

Fry/Fingerling: Trout or kokanee that have been reared at WDFW facilities that were released at 10 to 600 fish per pound. Trout fry/fingerlings released in 2012 will harvestable in 2013. Kokanee fry/fingerlings released in 2012 will be harvestable in fall 2014/spring 2015.
